WHAT IS A TIP VOLUNTEER?

TIP volunteers are called by local police, fire, medical, and hospital personnel to respond to scenes of sudden or unexpected death (natural, suicide, accidental) and other traumatic incidents. Volunteers provide emotional and practical support to family, friends, witnesses, and victims.



WHAT IS REQUIRED?

- Must be 16 years of age
- Clean driving record
- Clean criminal background
- 36-hours in-class training
- 3-month field training
- Reliable vehicle
- Access to a computer
